

SCOPE OF WORK (CONSTRUCTION BUDGET - \$360K)

- **Provide a Barrier to Help Keep Children within the 2-5 Play Area** Fencing was suggested on the Woodstock Street side of the park. Preferably, this would only partially enclose the 2-5 play area. This would help alleviate concerns regarding children being able to run out into the street. Additionally, there was discussion of bike commuters speeding through on the adjacent pathway, posing a potential conflict between the seating area on the other side of the pathway and children attempting to cross over the path to get to the seating.
- **Shade Structure** to be placed over part of the existing picnic area. Not only is the structure to provide adequate shade, but it should be aesthetically pleasing as well.
- Lighting low-level lighting along the main pathway with 15' spacing.
- **Power Outlets (2)** installation of outlets that could be used for events at the park. One outlet should be placed near the entry kiosk and another near the basketball court. In addition, provide USB ports at picnic area.
- Additional Adirondack Chairs (4) to match the existing chairs.
- **Picnic Tables (3)** to replace two old picnic tables and provide a third picnic table in the lawn area adjacent to the 2-5 play area.
- Youth Basketball Hoop portable unit to be placed on the north side of the existing court centerline.
- Native Plantings native seed mix under existing trees at Woodstock Street entrance.
- Invasive Plant Removal remove invasive plants behind fencing, north of the playground.
- **New Trees** to be coordinated with and planted by Urban Forestry.













